

## **POLL WORKER INFORMATION SHEET**

Thank you for your interest in becoming a Poll Worker for Clarke County. To qualify as a poll worker, you must be at least 18 years of age and a registered voter in Clarke County. Prior to each election, Poll Workers will be appointed from a list of qualified workers from each precinct. In most instances, Poll Workers serve in the precinct in which they vote.

Poll Worker training is held prior to each election. As per Alabama law, it is a requirement that each Poll Worker be trained prior to every election. Training schools are held up to sixty days before every election, and the amount of compensation that the Poll Workers receive for working the election is dependent upon attending the school.
