

ATTENTION: Pursuant to Act 2003-381 one of the following forms of identification is required in order for you to vote.

A. Current Valid Photo Identification

1. Governmentally Produced Photo Identification (current and valid)
2. Employee Identification for Employee w/Photo of Employee produced by the Employer (current and valid)
3. College or University (within Alabama) Photo Identification Card (current and valid)
4. Post Graduate Technical or Professional School (within Alabama) Photo Identification Card (current and valid)

OR

B. One of the following:

5. Utility Bill of Voter with Voter's name and address (current)
6. Bank Statement with Voter's name and address (current)
7. Government Check with Voter's name and address (current)
8. Paycheck with Voter's name and address (current)
9. Valid Identification card (authorized by law) issued by the State of Alabama (including any branch, department, agency, or entity of the State of Alabama)
10. Valid Identification card (authorized by law) issued by any of the other 49 states (including any branch, department, agency, or entity of that State)
11. Valid Identification card (authorized by law) issued by the United States of America "Federal Government" (including any branch, department, agency, or entity of the Federal Government)
12. Valid United States Passport
13. Valid Alabama Hunting License
14. Valid Alabama Fishing License
15. Valid Alabama Pistol/Revolver Permit
16. Valid Pilot's License issued by the FAA or other authorized agency of the Federal Government
17. Valid United States Military Identification
18. Birth Certificate (Certified Copy)
19. Valid Social Security Card
20. Naturalization documentation (Certified Copy)
21. Court Record of Adoption (Certified Copy)
22. Court Record of name change (Certified Copy)
23. Valid Medicaid Card
24. Valid Medicare Card
25. Valid Electronic Benefits Transfer Card
26. Other Government Document that shows the name and address of the voter (valid or certified document issued by a government agency)

NOTE: Those items listed in 5-26 can be the original document (license, card, etc.) or a photocopy of that document (license, card, etc.)

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE ONE OF THESE FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION, PLEASE SEE THE CHIEF INSPECTOR.

In addition, an individual who does not have identification in his or her possession at the polls shall be permitted to vote if the individual is positively identified by two election officials as a voter on the poll list who is eligible to vote and the election official signs the voters list by where the voter signs.
